Who we are

What information we collect

When you use our contact or booking form, we collect:

- Your name
- Email address
- Phone number
- Any message or booking details you provide (e.g. property address, preferred shoot dates)

We do not collect payment details, account passwords, or order history through this website, and we do not knowingly collect information from children.

Our website host may automatically log basic technical information (such as IP address and browser type) needed to keep the site running securely, this is standard for any website and is not used to identify you personally or for advertising.

How we use your information

We use the information you give us to:

- Respond to your enquiry and arrange photography bookings
- Communicate with you about scheduling, invoicing, and delivery of images
- Keep records for our own business and accounting purposes
- Comply with legal obligations where applicable

Our legal basis for this processing is either that it's necessary to take steps towards a contract with you (arranging a shoot), or our legitimate interest in responding to business enquiries.

We do not sell, rent, or share your personal information with third parties for their own marketing purposes.

Who we share information with

We may share information with trusted service providers who help us run our business, such as:

- Our website hosting provider
- Email and calendar tools we use to manage enquiries and bookings
- Our accountant, where necessary for invoicing

These providers only receive the information needed to perform their service and are not permitted to use it for their own purposes.

Cookies

Our website may use essential cookies needed for the site to function correctly (for example, to support the contact form). We do not currently use advertising or tracking cookies. If this changes, we will update this policy and, where required by law, ask for your consent.

How long we keep your information

We keep enquiry and booking information for as long as needed to deliver our services and meet our accounting and legal obligations, after which it is deleted or anonymised.

Your rights

Under UK GDPR, you have the right to:

- Ask what personal information we hold about you
- Ask us to correct inaccurate information
- Ask us to delete your information
- Object to or restrict how we use your information
- Withdraw consent, where we rely on consent
